

### WHAT ARE TAKIWĀ ELECTIONS?

- Te Rūnanga-Ā-Iwi-O-Ngāpuhi is governed by a board of 9 Trustees, elected by nine Takiwā regions.
- Takiwā hold elections on a three yearly cycle to elect their Trustee, Proxy Trustee and Executive Committee (the Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer)

### WHICH TAKIWĀ ARE UP FOR ELECTION THIS YEAR? [*Schedule 1, s.5(a), p.42*]

- Te Rōpū Takiwā o Mangakāhia, Te Rūnanga o Taumārere ki Rākaumangamanga and Te Takiwā o Ngāpuhi ki Whangārei.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE OR STAND FOR ELECTION? [*Schedule 1, ss.10-13, ss.19-23, p.45-49*]

- Nominees/candidates and voters must be adult (18 years+) members registered with the Rūnanga and eligible to vote in respect of their primary Takiwā (Te Rōpū Takiwā o Mangakāhia, Te Rūnanga o Taumārere ki Rākaumangamanga and Te Takiwā o Ngāpuhi ki Whangārei) as recorded on their registration application form.
- Candidates must be experienced, active in their Takiwā and demonstrate knowledge of Ngāpuhi traditions and tikanga
- Trustee and Proxy Trustee candidates must meet the requirements specified in section 16 of the Charities Act 2005
- Any adult registered member may nominate a person for election as a Trustee, Proxy Trustee and Executive Committee member of any Takiwā

### WHEN IS THE ELECTION HELD? [*Schedule 1, s.15, p.47*]

- **If** more than one nominee is accepted as a candidate for any position, the Rūnanga advertises the election 20 working days prior to the Takiwā AGM (Notice of candidates)
- Voting papers will be available on the website and from the Rūnanga office

### HOW DO I VOTE? [*Schedule 1, s.20, p.47-48*]

- Votes can be cast in person at the Takiwā AGM or by postal vote.
- The signed postal vote must be received by the Returning Officer at the Rūnanga by 5pm on the last business day prior to the Takiwā AGM. Please post voting forms to: The Returning Officer, 16 Mangakahia Road, PO Box 263, Kaikohe 0440.

### WHEN ARE WE NOTIFIED ABOUT THE ELECTION RESULTS? [*Schedule 1, ss.17-18, p.47*]

- The Returning Officer conducts the election process and informs Takiwā of the results.
- The Takiwā formally advise candidates of the election outcome. (Provisional results will be posted on the Te Rūnanga-Ā-Iwi O Ngāpuhi website and Facebook.)
- Official election results are announced at the Rūnanga AGM on Saturday, 14 November 2020
- Newly elected Trustees, Proxy Trustees and Executive Committee members take office following the election results announcement

### WHO IS THE RETURNING OFFICER? [*Schedule 1, s.17, p.47*]

- The Returning Officer is the Chief Executive Officer of Te Rūnanga-Ā-Iwi O Ngāpuhi.
